ELIGIBILITY

The Championships is open to all foreign and local players, who are not suspended or banned by the WSF and ASF.

All players must be WSF registered (SPIN) and their registration must be in good standing at the time of entry and then at the time of actual participation.

All player entries must be endorsed by their respective National Association or Federation.

Verification of correct date of birth from passport will be required.

For players who need to **APPLY VISA, please submit their entries **AS EARLY AS POSSIBLE** to ensure an enough time for visa application.*

Withdrawal

Withdrawal of players from the Championships must be notified to the Tournament Director by email. Entry fee is **NON-REFUNDABLE** if withdrawal received **after the closing date**.

Appeal

Any appeal should report to the organising committee and the decision made from Technical Delegate shall be final.

Seeding

Organizer shall be responsible for seeding of individuals as required after the entries are closed. The draw will be made and announced **on or before 29 August 2019**.

Tournament Format for single events

Scoring & Format

All matches will be played to the best of 5 games, 11 points - PAR (Point-A-Rally). WSF Rules of the World Singles Game will be applied throughout the tournament.

Players may be required to play more than one match a day.

Main Draw - There shall be **NO** play-off for 3/4 position (3rd place trophy to both losing semi-finalists of Main Draw).

Plate Events - There shall be a championship plate event for all players defeated in their first match. Any other plate will be announced once the entries are closed.

In the event of less than 6 entries in any age-group the Organizer may, at its discretion, combine adjust age-group or run small draws in a round-robin format. Affected players will be advised accordingly.

USE OF KCC FACILITIES

Each player will be eligible for temporary membership of the Club from 4-9 September 2019, both dates inclusive.

During this period, all players will be allowed to make use of the Club's sports and leisure facilities free of charge.

Temporary members will also be allowed to make use of the Club's food and beverage outlets. Details of the Club's sports and leisure facilities, food and beverage outlets and the hours of operation can be found on the Club's website.

Temporary members who wish to use the Club's food and beverage outlets will be required to purchase a debit card to pay for their food and beverage consumption in the Club. Cash cannot be used anywhere in the Club.

Temporary members must carry their temporary membership card with them at all

times when in the Club. Temporary members will be required to show their temporary membership card when making use of the Club's sports and leisure facilities.

The Club does not permit the use of mobile phones to make voice calls inside the Club's premises. A fine of HK700 will be levied for breaches of this regulation.

Multiple breaches may result in temporary membership privileges being terminated. All temporary members are subject to club rules.

TOURNAMENT T-SHIRT

All participants will receive a tournament T-shirt.

INDEMNITY & INSURANCE

All participating associations, competitors and officials agree to indemnify and hold the organising committee, Hong Kong Squash and Asian Squash Federation free and unaccountable for and against any claims for personal injury, death or property damage, arising out of or in any way resulting from the participation in the Championships.

NEWS & COMMUNICATION

Information Boards will be located at the Championship Venues. Participants should consult the Information Boards on a regular basis for updated news.

FUNCTIONS

Welcome Dinner will be held on 4 September 2019, at 6:30pm at Kowloon Cricket Club.

Farewell Cocktail will be held on 8 September 2019 at Kowloon Cricket Club, immediate after the prize presentation.

Trophies for all events will be presented immediately on the conclusion of all matches, in the afternoon of the finals day on 8 September 2019.

OFFICIAL BALLS

The Dunlop Revelation Pro XX (double yellow dot) ball will be the official ball for the championships.

PERSONAL BELONGINGS

It is the players' responsibility to keep their own belongings safe and close by while in the Venue. Please DO NOT leave any personal belongings include the squash bags

unattended any time. The Organiser will not be liable or responsible for any loss, theft or damage to your personal belongings.

PLAYERS ON COURT

It is the responsibility of each player to be ready to play 15 minutes before the start time of match.

PRACTICE COURTS

Practice courts in KCC are available one day before the tournament (4 September 2019).

Each player can only book ONE session (30 minutes).

Courts are allocated in a first come first serve basis.

RACKET-STRINGING SERVICE

Rackets stringing service will be available at the venue.

TIN HEIGHT

The tin height for the 4th Asian Master Championship shall be 19 inches.

VISA INFORMATION

Hong Kong Squash will apply for the work visa exemption for the overseas players but it is subject to the approval of the Hong Kong Immigration Department. The Organizer will inform the players if any news updated from the authorizing department.

But for those players who are national requiring visas to come to Hong Kong for visit, they should submit application for entry visa at least 6 weeks in advance before travelling. For more details, please visit the below link: -

The **visa application fee (USD25)** is non-refundable, regardless of the visa application result. In addition, the successful visa applicant will have to pay for a **DHL delivery charge (USD70)**.

Players from non-visa free countries are strongly advised to contact **Ms. Emily Mak, Executive Director of Hong Kong Squash (email: emilymak@hksquash.org.hk)** on or **before 15 July 2019** so as to allow enough time for their visa application.

ASF CODE OF CONDUCT

The following offences may be subject to penalties and/or disciplinary action.

The following offences may be subject to penalties under Rule 15 of the International Singles Game of Squash and of the International Doubles Game or Squash, and/or be subject to disciplinary action by the ASF Disciplinary & Appeals Committee:

AB1. A participant who verbally or physically abuses his opponent, the Marker, Referee, officials, spectators or sponsors.

AB2. A participant who shows dissent to the Marker, Referee or officials, including foul or profane language and obscene or offensive gestures.

AB3. A participant who abuses playing equipment or the court

AB4. A participant who fails to comply with the conditions of entry of a Championship including any rules with regards to clothing or advertising.

AB5. A participant who having entered a championship or accepted an invitation to play withdraws from the event or fails to attend.

AB6. A participant who fails to complete a match for a reason other than injury, illness or emergency situation.

AB7. A participant who defaults from a Championship. The Disciplinary & Appeals Committee may require evidence or proof of 'bona fide' injury, illness or other emergency situation.

AB8. A participant who fails to make himself available to meet reasonable request for interview by the media.

AB9. A participant who does not comply with the Rules or spirit of the Game.

AB10. A participant guilty of any other unreasonable conduct which brings the Game into disrepute, including behaviour as a result of intoxication by any means including recreational substances such as alcohol, marijuana and hallucinogens.
