### **1. Age Group Events**

U19, U17, U15, U13, U11, U9 events for boys and girls. Players may only enter one age category, either in the appropriate age category or in a higher age category, if so desired.

Plate matches will be offered (Minimum 2~3 matches depending on the draw).

Participants will receive WSF ranking points (under 19) & ASF ranking points for all categories except Under 9 category. **ALL players are required to play ALL scheduled matches in order to gain the points with no exception.** If an age category has fewer than 8 players, it may be cancelled, then the player may play in a higher age category.
