Standard Features in Conducting ASF Coaching Course

Objectives

- To support the development of squash across Asia via professional training & development for coaching.
- To provide assistance for National Squash Federation to nurture the potential coaches in all levels

Course Duration

• Level 1 : Approx. 4 to 5 days

Level 2 : Approx. 6 to 7 days

• Level 3: Approx. 7 to 8 days

Requirements for Participants

- Level 1 : Preferred 3 years of squash experience, subjected to the approval of National Squash Federation.
- Level 2: Qualified ASF Level 1 Coach for minimum 1 year or equivalent, subjected to the approval of ASF Coaching Committee.
- Level 3 : Qualified ASF Level 2 Coach for minimum 2 years or equivalent, subjected to the approval of ASF Coaching Committee.
- Participants of all 3 Levels MUST be endorsed by their respective National Squash Federation.

Course Tutor

- All the Coaching Course should be conducted by qualified ASF Tutors at appropriate levels.
- A list of qualified ASF Tutors can be referred to ASF official website (www.asiansquash.org)

Costs of Host Federation

- Payment for ASF Tutor for travel via most direct route (including ancillary costs such as personal travel / medical insurance, visa fees, any vaccination / medication costs considered necessary for travel to the host country).
- Accommodation (single room) at a 4-star hotel.
- All 3 meals per day or USD40.00 per day if meals are not provided, including the day before and the day after the event.
- All transport within the host country as required.
- Tuition fee for ASF Tutor:

- a. Level 1: USD150.00 per day
- b. Level 2: USD200.00 per day
- c. Level 3 / ASF Tutor Course: USD250.00 per day
- ** The Host Federation should provide the above-mentioned tuition fee per day including the day before and the day after the event.
- Any other relevant incidental expenses.
