Singapore Junior Squash Open 2023 is an ASF Gold event organised by Singapore Squash Rackets Association. Junior participants will receive ASF ranking points.

The event has also been registered as a PSA/WSF National Junior Open. Under-17 and Under-19 Participants with a PSA membership may claim PSA points, subject to minimum draw sizes (16 player draw).

ASF Sanctioned Junior Events

Boys & Girls: Under 11, 13, 15, 17, 19

- Each participant can enter (1) event only and will be guaranteed a minimum of 2 matches.
- Age Categories may be combined due to low entry at the discretion of the organiser.

Seeding

- The Seeding will be solely carried out by SSRA, using the latest AJSS ranking available as the basis.
- PSA Rankings will also be taken into consideration, if appropriate.

Age Cut-off Date

17 December 2023 for all age groups

Entry Requirements

- Open to all foreign and local players not banned by WSF, ASF and/or SSRA.
- All foreign entries must be **endorsed** by their respective National Squash Association (through the Excel Entry Form).
- Please provide your correct date of birth. They will be verified from your passport and/or NRIC.
- **SPIN NUMBER:** All local and foreign participants are required to have a WSF SPIN Number. Entries without a SPIN number will be rejected.
- You may register for a WSF SPIN number at <http://www.worldsquash.org/ws/spins> A fee is required for SPIN registration.

Entry Closing Date

- Entries must be received before **1st November 2023, 1159pm Singapore Time**. Late entries or entries without the entry fee will not be accepted.

Entry Fees, Entry Withdrawal & Late Withdrawal

- You must notify SJO@sgsquash.com of any withdrawal with valid reasons. Entry fees **will not be refunded** if withdrawal is done after the closing date.
- All entry fees must be transferred by the closing date. No Payment on Arrival will be entertained. We will remove names who have not paid the entry fees by 1 Nov 2023.
- Paid up entry fee is non-transferable between participants.
- **Late withdrawal.** Withdrawal after the closing date will be considered 'late withdrawal'. All late withdrawals must be accompanied by a Medical Certificate (MC) or any official documentation, subject to the approval of the Organiser. Failing to do so will result in the participant scoring 'ZERO' AJSS ranking points which will be reflected as one of the participant's best 4 results. For those who produce an MC or official documentation, ASF will evaluate each withdrawal on a case-by-case basis. Entry fee is still payable for all LATE WITHDRAWALS.

- All participants will receive a tournament T-shirt. Do specify your t-shirt size correctly. Sizes in (inches) 34, 36, 38, 40, 42, 44, 46.
- No exchange of t-shirt sizes will be entertained.

Scoring & Format

- Tournament format will be determined by the organiser depending on the draw size.
- Scoring - 11 points – PAR (Point-A-Rally) following the WSF Singles Rules.
- Check-in 45 minutes before the scheduled match time. Match timing is an indication only. Matches will be played on a **FOLLOW-ON-BASIS** (matches will be called to start when the preceding match ends). **Postponement of the match will not be entertained.**
- All participants must Referee the following match, failure to do so may result in a walkover.
- Walkover will be awarded against participants who are more than 15 minutes late upon being called to start the match; subsequent matches will be forfeited; no points and rankings will be awarded unless a valid MC is produced **and** notice is given to the organiser prior to the start of the match.
- Participants will be expected to play up to two matches a day.

Practice Courts (for Foreign Participants Only)

Available on 12th December 2023 on an allocation and first come first serve basis. The organiser has the right to alter and limit the allocated times at any time to ensure that everyone can practice. Please book considerably. Email your request to SJO@sqsquash.com

Prize Money & Prizes

- Top 4 Placing: Prize or Prize Money + Medal
- 5-8th Placing: Medal Only
 - *Medals for 5-8 will only be available if there is minimally a 16-draw.
- Prize presentation shall be held on 17th December 2023 (Sunday) immediately after the finals of the last event.
- It is mandatory for prize winners to be present personally for the prize presentation ceremony in the tournament t-shirt to receive their prizes. No singlets, slippers and sandals are allowed.
- Prizes, medals, or prize money will be forfeited if it is not collected during the prize presentation ceremony.
