VENUE AND ACCOMMODATION

ENTRY FEE

The ENTRY FEE of USD330 per player/official covers 6 nights (check-in on 30th June 2025, check-out on 6th July 2025) accommodation with breakfast inclusive on TWIN SHARING basis. Each boys and girls team shall only redeem for their officials MAXIMUM TWO rooms with the rates stated above respectively. The team shall be responsible for paying the room-rate difference for any SINGLE occupancy.

For **SINGLE OCCUPANCY**, the **ENTRY FEE is USD660 per player/official** covers 6 nights (check-in on 30th June 2025, check-out on 6th July 2025) accommodation with breakfast inclusive. Provision of single rooms are subject to prior request and availability.

The entry fee without the accommodation package is USD100 per player or official.

For additional room-nights, a special rate of **USD100** per single/twin room per night with breakfast inclusive will be offered. Booking MUST be made through the Organiser and is subject to room availability. This special room rate is also available for officials or supporters of the participating MNAs.

Entry fees must be paid by 2^{nd} June 2025.

All bank charges at both ends (remitting and receiving banks) of the telegraphic transfer are to be borne by the participating MNAs.

All players and officials are responsible for all extra cost incurred at the Hotel and the Venue, other than the breakfasts provided by the Hotel on specified dates. All players and officials must settle the bill for all their extra personal expenses to hotel reception before departure.

SEEDING AND DRAW

The ASF Seeding Committee shall be responsible for seeding of individuals. They will produce the FINAL individual seeding **no later than 17th June 2025**. The decision of the ASF Seeding Committee shall be final.

Details on Seeding and Draw, please refer to M8 of ASF Championship Regulations.

The draws will be made and announced no later than 23rd June 2025.

CHAMPIONSHIP REGULATIONS

The Championships will be run in accordance with the ASF Championship Regulations.

CLOTHING REGULATIONS

Regulation L of the ASF Championship Regulations shall apply.

DOPE TESTING

Dope testing may be carried out in accordance with the WADA Code.

All players are required to complete and sign the Doping Declaration (see attached) acknowledging the WSF's Anti-Doping Rules and Regulations and the Doping rules set out in Regulations E12 - E15 of the ASF Championship Regulations prior to competing in the Championships as part of the accreditation process.

Any players refusing to undergo a doping control and any player found guilty of a doping infraction proven by a positive laboratory test result will be dealt with by the ASF, which shall take disciplinary actions and penalties in accordance with its regulations.

ELIGIBILITY – IMPORTANT!

All juniors participating in the Championships must be under 19 years of age as at 5^{th} July 2025. All managers are required to present the passports of their players to the ASF Technical Delegate – to confirm eligibility before being permitted to compete. This has to be done by 30^{th} June 2025 at the Championship Office at the Main Venue.

All players, coaches and designated team officials must be WSF registered (SPIN) and their registration must be in good standing at the time of entry and then at the time of actual participation. Players and coaches and designated team officials are required to provide their WSF SPIN Number on the Biography Form (Form B) which should be submitted on 2nd June 2025.

EYEWEAR

In accordance with Regulation G5 of the ASF Championship Regulations, all junior players (under 19 years of age) are required to wear protective eyewear (manufactured to an approved national safety standard) properly over the eyes at all times during practice and match play throughout the Championships.

All junior players are required to sign the Eyewear Declaration (see attached) acknowledging acceptance and compliance with this requirement prior to competing in the Championships.

Entries

Each MNA shall be allowed **AN INITIAL MAXIMUM OF TWO PLAYERS** in each category. If there are slots available after the closing date, MNAs shall be allowed to enter two additional players, which will be allocated as follows:

- a. First on merit to players ranked in the PSA/ASF as per rankings published on or before the Closing Date.
- b. To higher ranked players as determined by the ASF Seeding Committee.

c. If there are more than 64 entries, players will be placed on a reserve list and can be called upon to play if slots become available due to withdrawals.

If there are still slots available, the Host Association may enter a maximum of four additional players.

The Championships are open to all Asian juniors provided that the player or the member nation has not been banned by the Asian Squash Federation. Each player can enter only ONE division in his/her age category or in a higher age category, if so desired.

Tournament Format:

All matches will be played to the best of 5 games, 11 points – PAR (Point-A-Rally). WSF Rules of the World Singles Game will be applied throughout the championship. All players are guaranteed A MINIMUM OF 2 MATCHES. Players will be expected to play two matches a day.

Main Draw - There shall be no play-off for 3^{rd} position or any other position. (3^{rd} place trophy will be presented to both losing semi-finalists of Main Draw.

Plate Events - There shall be a championship plate event for first round losers. Any other plate will be announced once the entries are closed. There shall be no play-off for 3rd position or any other position.

FOREIGN CURRENCY EXCHANGE

The currency of SOUTH KOREA is WON and the approximate official prevailing rate is USD1 = 1,500WON

FUNCTIONS

Welcome / Opening Ceremony

A Welcome Dinner will be held at the Championship Hotel on **30th June 2025**. Formal Team attire is to be worn by all players and officials. Attendance is a mandatory for all.

Medal Award Ceremony

The official medal award ceremonies will take place on court following the completion of the finals on 5th July 2025. Medal winners are expected to be available at the venue wearing team tracksuits.

Closing Ceremony

INDEMNITY & INSURANCE

All participating associations and its delegated competitors / officials SHOULD agree to indemnify and hold the Korea Squash Federation and Asian Squash Federation free and unaccountable for and against any claims for personal injury, death or property damage, arising out of or in any way resulting from the participation in the said tournament.

MAIL, FAX, E-MAIL, INTERNET & TELEPHONE SERVICE

Incoming faxes and other appropriate correspondence received before or during the Championships will be placed in the relevant country's mail box at the Championship Office at the *Championship Venue*.

Telephones

Players and officials **will not be permitted** to use telephones installed in the administration offices. All calls must be made at your own expense from rooms or public telephones at the hotel or elsewhere.

Messages

If telephone calls are received and the person cannot be quickly located, a message will be placed on the Information Board. The Organisers do not take any responsibility for messages that are not collected by participants.

MEDICAL

Medical Team will be available on site throughout all sessions of play. In the case of medical emergencies and/or accidents, please report to the Championship Office for assistance and necessary action.

NATIONAL FLAG

Each team is required to bring their national flag for use during the Championships. Please hand it to the Championship Office at the Venue upon arrival.

NEWS & COMMUNICATION

Information Boards

Information Boards will be located at the Championship hotel and venue. Participants should consult the Information Boards on a regular basis for updated news.

Team's Mail Boxes

Team's mail boxes are situated in the Championship Office at the Venue. For the smooth running of the Championships, Team Managers are suggested to visit the office regularly to collect their team's information sheets and daily results.

Electronic Communications

For rapid communication and information dissemination between the Championship Director and the Team Managers, electronic communications such as email or WhatsApp will be used. Please provide your Team Manager's email address and mobile contact number in Form C.

OFFICIAL BALL

The Dunlop Revelation Pro XX ball (double yellow dot black ball & yellow dot white ball) will be used for the championships. For matches played at the glass court, Dunlop white ball will be used.

PERSONAL BELONGINGS

It is the players' responsibility to keep their own belongings safe and close by while in the Venue. Please DO NOT leave any personal belongings include the squash bags unattended at any time. The Organiser will not be liable or responsible for any loss, theft or damage to your personal belongings.

PLAYERS ON COURT

It is the responsibility of each player to be ready to play at the advertised start time of match.

PRACTICE COURTS

Practice courts (free of charge) will be available for all players.

Racket-stringing services will be provided at the Championship Venue. An official stringer will be appointed and information will be passed to the Team Managers during the Team Managers' Meeting.

TEAM MANAGERS' MEETINGS

There will be a team managers meeting at the official hotel on 30th June 2025 at 17:00. If further meetings are required, a notice will be sent out via Whatsapp or will be placed on the Information Board.

TEAM MANAGEMENT

Upon arrival at the Championships, Team Manager will be the official and sole representative of his/her players in all matters including receiving and giving instructions, except when an individual match has started, when the Rules of the Game shall apply.

TEAM/PLAYERS PHOTOGRAPHS

Teams/Players may have their photograph taken by the official photographer during the Championships.

TIN HEIGHT

In accordance with WSF and ASF practice for World and Asian Championships, the tin height for all junior championships shall be 19 inches.

All participants will receive a tournament T-shirt.
