The 8TH Borneo Junior Open 2025 is organized by Squash Racquets Association Sarawak and sanctioned by Asian Squash Federation. It is a **GOLD** Asian Junior Super Series Event [AJSS] and junior participants will receive ASF ranking points.

- All foreign/local player(s) entries <u>must be endorsed</u> by their respective National/State Association/Federation.
- All players must give their correct Date of Birth as passports/Identification Cards may be performed
- Please be advised that ALL players competing in ALL AGE GROUPS for this event WILL BE REQUIRED TO HAVE a WSF SPIN registration number which can be obtained at <u>http://www.worldsquash.org/spin.</u> There is payment required. ENTRIES WITHOUT SPIN NUMBER WILL BE REJECTED.
- All **local Malaysian players** are required to have **MYSPIN** to participate in the tournament.
- All players are required to complete the official entry form(s) and email to sraswk2010@gmail.com along with the entry fee bank transfer slip.
- All players are also required to register for this tournament in the Ranked In System as The Organizers will be using this system to update the results online. Players must register for a Ranked In account first. Please go register for the account which is free. Please indicate your state or country's initial in the First Name Column and your full name in the Last Name Column.

CLOSING DATE OF ENTRY

- ♦ Entries must be received before SUNDAY 25th May 2025 at 1159PM Malaysian Time.
- ♦ LATE ENTRIES OR ENTRIES WITHOUT CONFIRMATION OF PAYMENT METHOD WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

PLAYER WITHDRAWAL & LATE WITHDRAWALS

- Any withdrawal from the Championship must be notified to The Tournament Secretariat as soon as possible by <u>email</u>. Anyone wishing to pay entry fees upon arrival will still be required to pay the entry fee even if he or she withdraws before the start of the tournament. Failing to pay the entry fee will result in the player being banned from this event in future until the fees owing are paid up. <u>Paid entry fees will not be refunded</u>.
- Paid up entry fee is not transferable from one player to another player in the event of a pull out.
- ♦ Late Withdrawals

Withdrawal after the Closing Date is considered 'late withdrawal'. All late withdrawals must be accompanied with a medical certificate or with relevant documents supporting valid reasons. Failure to do either will result in the player being given "**ZERO**" ranking points. The **ZERO** ranking points will be reflected as one of the players 4 best results. For those who have produced the relevant documents, ASF will evaluate each withdrawal on a case-tocase basis.

NATIONAL RANKING

All participants are advised to include their national and ASF's AJSS rankings in their entry forms. This would facilitate us in preparing the draws for the tournament. Entry Forms must be endorsed by the State/National Association or Federation. Forms that are not endorsed will likely to be rejected by organizers.

MATCH FORMAT

- 1. The tournament is based on a circuit format
- 2. 11 points PAR (Point A Rally)
- 3. Best of five games format for:
 - a. all winning players in main draw
 - b. top 8 placing
- 4. All other placements shall be the best of the three games format.
- 5. All Rounds are played Top Down except for Final Rounds which shall be played Bottom Up.

INDEMNITY & INSURANCE

All participating associations and its delegated competitors / officials **SHOULD** agree to indemnity and hold the organizing committee, Squash Racquet Association Sarawak and Squash Racquet Association Malaysia free and unaccountable for and against any claims for personal injury, death or property damage, arising out of or in any way resulting from the participation in the said tournament.

CLOSING/PRIZE PRESENTATION CEREMONY

- Please note that the matches may be scheduled to finish late in the afternoon on the final day (Sunday 20th July 2025) if the number of participants is huge. The Closing/Prize Presentation Ceremony is expected to be held immediately after the last match of the final day. The top 8 positions will receive their prizes at this ceremony.
- ♦ Participants <u>must</u> wear the tournament T-Shirt during the Closing/Prize presentation ceremony.
- Prize Winners who do not wear the tournament T-shirt and who are not properly attired (<u>must</u> wear shoes) shall not be allowed to receive their medals and prizes on the podium.

PRACTICE/TEST COURTS

There will be no more test court bookings after that.

DRINKING WATER BOTTLES

- ♦ The Organizers want all participants, officials and spectators to help them to Go Green.
- ♦ One of the biggest forms of pollution in our ocean is plastic and disposable plastic drinking water bottles is one of the most widespread pollutants. Thus, disposable plastic water bottles are strongly discouraged at the tournament venue.
- Please assist us by <u>not</u> bringing disposable plastic bottles into the venue. Instead, please bring your own water container. The Organizers have made provision for ample hot and cold-water dispensers to be available for you at the Water Station at the venue.

OTHER NOTES/REMINDERS

- ♦ All officials and players must ensure they are at the court <u>One (1) Hour</u> before their matches start.
- All players **MUST** check their next round matches before leaving the venue.
- \diamond Walkover will be given, if the player is late by 15 minutes by the time the name is called.
 - ♦ All players need to be a marker or referee (when required) after their match.
 - ♦ Tournament Referee will brief on Injuries and Illness Time
 - Female players are not allowed to wear "compression tight" sportswear unless it's with a skirt over it.
 - Reminder that "no coaching from coaches & parents" during the rally. Referees will give warnings to coaches or parents if this happens. Penalty (conduct warning, conduct stroke, conduct match) will be given to players.
