Entry Submission

- All overseas entries MUST be submitted using the attached official entry form (Appendix 1) through the respective National Association together with the copy of the player's passport.
- The completed entry form with the entry fee bank transfer slip have to email to Mr. Jovi Au, Tournament Director (jovi@hksquash.org.hk)

Closing Date of Overseas Entries

- Entries must be received by 1200 NOON (HK Time) on or before 6 June 2025 (Friday).
- · Late entries or Entries without the entry fee will not be accepted.

Player withdrawal

• Withdrawal from the Championship must be notified to Squash Association of Hong Kong, China as soon as possible by email. Entry Fees will not be refunded after the closing date of overseas entries.

Scoring & Format

- Main Draw match is competing in best of 5 games, 11 points PAR (Point-A-Rally) and following the WSF Singles Rules 2024. All Plate Event scoring & format is subject to the match schedule.
- Format of each division will be decided by Squash Association of Hong Kong, China, which will depend on the number of entries.
- All players are guaranteed A MINIMUM OF 2 MATCHES.

Seeding

 Organizer shall be responsible for seeding of individuals with the reference of the Asian Junior Ranking (June 2025) as prime factor. The National Junior Ranking as of the month of June 2025, and the current form will also be considered.

Official Ball

• Dunlop Pro Balls will be used during the Tournament.

Local Transportation

- Shuttle bus service between official hotel and match venue will be provided on a limited basis. The priority of shuttle bus service will be given to those who take our hotel package.
- Players and officials are also encouraged to walk or take the hotel shuttle bus to Causeway Bay and Wan
 Chai MTR Station and transit train to Kowloon Tong MTR Station (Venue #1) or Admiralty MTR Station
 (Venue #2).

Flight Information & Airport Transfer Service

- For those foreign participants who are taking our hotel package are required to fill in the flight information form (Appendix 2) attached by <u>7 July 2025 (Monday)</u>.
- All airport arrivals / departures transportation arrangement in Hong Kong will only be provided for those staying at the tournament hotel and using the hotel package.

Tournament T-shirt

• All players will receive a championship souvenir T-shirt for FREE.

Visas (For all players and officials)

- The Immigration Department of the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region launched the Immigration Facilitation Scheme for Visitors Participating in Short-term Activities in Designated Sectors ("the STV Scheme") https://www.immd.gov.hk/eng/services/visas/stv.html. Under the STV Scheme, eligible persons invited by authorized host organisations can, during a period of up to 14 consecutive calendar days, participate in designated short-term activities as visitors without an employment visa/entry permit. Squash Association of Hong Kong, China is one of the authorized host organisations and we are required to issue an invitation letter to ALL non-local invitees under the Pilot Scheme, including both visa-required and visa-free nationals. For those visa-required countries, a proper visa application procedure still needs to be arranged without any exceptions and will be required to contact the Tournament Director Jovi Au (jovi@hksquash.org.hk) at least 6-8 weeks before the tournament start for the necessary arrangement.
- Kindly understand this is a compulsory requirement by the Immigration Department of the Government of
 HKSAR and the individual travellers may need to present the invitation letter for immigration check at
 customs when arriving in Hong Kong and/or any on-the-spot check at the competition venue upon request
 by the immigration officer.
- All foreign participants including players, officials & coaches require to submit the passport copy together with the endorsed entry.
